2025 Pennant – Conditions of Entry

1. **Entrance Fee** – There will be an entrance fee of \$100, payable by the 14th of March, to cover administrative expenses.
2. **Green Fees** – The competition is conducted along the lines of Pennant play with no green fees on the day.
3. **Type of Play** – The competition is singles scratch match play over 18 holes.
4. **Team Size ~ Scoring**
 - Size** – Teams comprise a minimum of 8 players.
 - Scoring** – Each Player scores one (1) point for each win and a half (1/2) point for a halved match.
 - Winner** – In Divisional Rounds the team with highest point score is the Game winner. If both teams have the same points score after all matches have been decided then the result is a draw.
5. **Divisions** – A Division, where possible, will comprise 7 teams, played on neutral courses where possible, with each team playing 6 games. For a 6 team Division, each team will play 5 games, and more than one course may be used to limit the tee times required at each club. For a 4 team Division, play will be home and away. Travel distances will be considered when determining the composition of Divisions. Where possible, the composition of Divisions will be reviewed annually to provide a variation in courses played.
6. **Caddies**

Caddies are acceptable and under the Rules of Golf are the only person that may give advice to their player. See Rule 9 in the Rules of Play for the latest advice.

7. Ride on Transport

Vehicles – Any form of Ride-on transport is allowable, subject to individual Club's policy.

Private Vehicles – Players wishing to use their own transport must obtain the Host Club's approval and comply with any Host Club insurance requirements.

Cart Hire – Clubs are requested to charge for cart hire at member rates. Should this not be the case then clubs are asked to advise of such at the time of submitting their Entry Form.

8. General

Course Availability for Final Series – Teams that agree for their course to be used as a neutral course in the case of a 6 team Division will not be asked to provide their course for a game in the Finals. Otherwise, all other teams' courses are to be made available for a game in the Finals.

The choice of a neutral golf club venue for the Grand Final will be made by the Committee reflecting the availability of the courses.

Halfway Refreshments – In keeping with the friendly yet competitive spirit that exists within the Pennant, the provision of refreshments is encouraged, however, it is a decision that is entirely at the discretion of each club.

Dress Rules – All players and caddies should be aware of, and must abide by, the dress regulations of the Host Club on the course, within the Clubhouse and Pro Shop precinct.
