

Handy Cap

1. Go to the Play Store or Google and type in Handy Cap. Install.
2. Press the Handy Cap icon to open the app.
3. Press "+" to add a new player.
4. Type in his name and GL number... press Done and then Save.
5. Continue to add players to your list.
6. An orange circle on the lhs with a number in it should be present. This is that players exact GA handicap to one decimal point.
7. If this circle is grey then press the ☰ symbol in the top left corner and go down to "Display playing handicap for course with a slope rating of 113" . Slide the small orange circle to the left opposite this statement to change the big orange circle on the previous page to Orange.
8. Go back one page and the big Orange circle will now have changed from Grey to Orange.
9. In that same ☰ symbol you can turn on such things as
 - a. Show last round
 - b. Show ID
 - c. Show home clubby sliding the small circle to the right and thus highlighting each option in orange.
10. By pressing the ☰ symbol you can sort all your entries by one of four ways. Suggestion is "sort by handicap."
11. The ↻ symbol is used to refresh any new scores that may come in to your players games. Use either wi fi or mobile data.
12. If you want to edit a player's details or delete them from your list then press the ⚙ symbol on the extreme right hand side of the players entry.
13. Once this all done press the players name and a green line indicating the history of that players handicap appears together with an orange graph indicating whether the player has played above or below his handicap.

Hopefully this explains how to use this valuable tool. There is a help menu as well located underneath the first page of "Player screen options". Scroll down to access it.
